LIFT OFF

Thank you to parents and students involved in our LIFT OFF program. I hope that we have provided our future families the opportunity to be familiar with our facilities, staff and operational/ways of working that occurs at our school. This program is important as we connect with our 2025 Prep students and their parents.

Orientation/Transition:

This term, our year 6 students were involved in a number of visits to the Dalby State High School, part of upper year's Orientation/transition program. At the lower end of our school, our LIFT OFF program supports Kindy students transitioning to primary school.

Points to consider about Transition/Orientation at Dalby State School:

- **Orientation opportunities** — help children and parents become familiar with the school setting and administrative matters such as how to enrol, uniforms and stationery requirements
- **Transition opportunities –ongoing partnership** with other learning institutions such as Kindys (before Prep) or local high school for students transitioning to secondary education.
- **Primary School readiness/Secondary school readiness and capacity building**— build the skills and abilities required by children, the capacity of parents and teachers to support the transition process and the readiness of the school to receive children of various ability levels

- **Parental engagement**— promote parents' engagement and commitment to their child's learning such as reading to children and connecting with their child's teachers, as well as parental participation in school life such as attending parent evenings and events. Encouraging parents to visit the local high schools "meet and greet" and information night.
- **Partnerships and relationships**— designed to promote and facilitate networks and collaborations between stakeholders which service to influence and support positive transition to school experiences.


